2019 Annual Report

In 2019 there were a total of 1,460 incidents entered into the PCO Critical Incident Management System, 1,185 of which were unique individuals. This represents a 10% decrease over 2018.

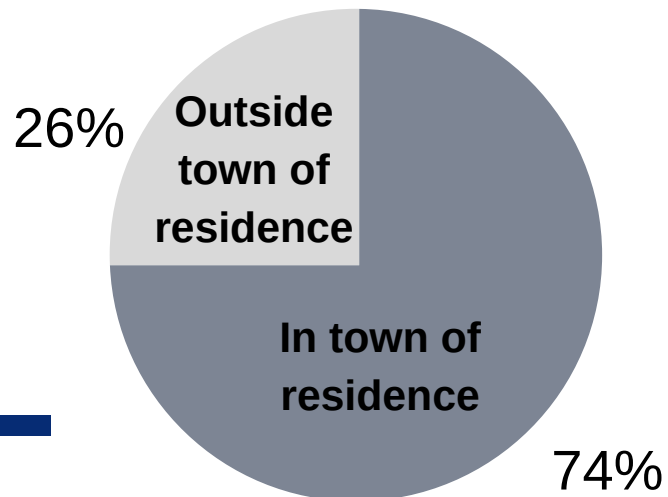
79% non-fatal
9% fatal
12% at-risk

This represents a 14% decrease in non-fatals, an 11% increase in fatalities and a 10% increase in at-risk referrals over 2018

Of the 837 attempted home visits, outreach teams made contact in 61% (514) of the visits



Of the 514 successful home visits, 55% (147) of the individuals accepted treatment and 19% (50) of the individuals were already seeking treatment
